Target Audience

- This course is ideal for joint (health and safety) committee members, worker health and safety representatives and corporate safety coordinators. This class may also be of interest to workers keen on gaining an understanding of violence in the workplace, factors associated with their work, and how to prevent them from happening.

 4. Develop a workplace violence program.
