Target Audience

- This course is ideal for joint (health and safety) committee members, new supervisors and small business owners.



Learning Outcomes

- Participants will:
 1. Know how to use the OHS Regulation and the WC Act to access health and safety requirements;
 2. Understand the basic causes of workplace injuries and illness;
 3. Learn how to identify, assess and control hazards in the workplace;
 4. Learn how to develop a safe work procedure based on a hazard assessment; and
 5. Apply the hazard recognition procedure to eliminate hazards or reduce risks in the worksite.



Delivery Method

The Hazard Recognition and Control class is divided into three parts:

- Theory;
- Table top exercise; and
- Practical case study.



Demonstration of Skills and Knowledge

- Perform a hazard assessment;
- Develop a safe work procedure for the worksite; and
- Complete a WorkSafeBC exam (75% passing grade required).

5. One of the following topics:
 - Basic WHMIS;
 - Lockout;
 - Fall protection; and
