

## 109 Injured at Work – Cared for at Work

*Instructional time – 1/2 day*



### Target Audience

- This course is ideal for First Aid Attendants, Joint Health and Safety Committee members and Supervisors in the workplace. This course is designed to describe an attendant's role in an effective first aid program and maximize the amount of employees treated at work rather than sending them for medical aid.



### Learning Outcomes

  1. Identify the role of the attendant;
  2. Identify wounds cared for at work; and
  3. Complete the first aid record.
