Target Audience

- The lockout program is intended for workers and supervisors who may be required to provide maintenance or repair work on a piece of machinery/equipment that requires lockout.



Learning Outcomes

- Participants will:
 1. Discuss the importance of locking out machinery and equipment;
 2. Understand the dangers of hazardous energy;
 3. Discuss when lockout is required;
 4. Understand basic and group lockout procedures; and
 5. Discuss employer's and workers' responsibilities for safe lockout.



Delivery Method

The Lockout class is divided into three parts:

- Theory;
- Table top exercise; and
- Practical case study.



Demonstration of Skills and Knowledge

- Participate in a lockout hazard assessment;
- Discuss safe work practices for locking out machinery/equipment specific to their workplace; and
- Practice scenario.
