

305 AED (Automated External Defibrillator)

Instructional time – 4.5 hours



Target Audience

- This course is for workers where an AED Program has been implemented in their workplace or for any individuals that would like to expand their knowledge of CPR to include AED training.

 1. Perform the priority action approach and primary survey;
 2. Learn how to perform Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) 1 Rescuer on an adult, child and infant (CPRC) and use an Automated External Defibrillator (AED);
 3. Learn when and how to use and AED;
 4. Learn how to develop an effective AED response program;



Delivery Method

The AED course is divided into 2 parts:

- Theory; and
- Practical.



Demonstration of Skills and Knowledge

- Demonstrate all first aid skills learned in the class.
