

306 Occupational First Aid Level 2

Instructional time – 35 hours



Target Audience

- This course is for workers requiring Occupational First Aid Training under the WCB Requirement.



Learning Outcomes

- Participants will:
 1. Perform the priority action approach and primary survey;
 2. Perform Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) 1 Rescuer on an Adult;
 3. Treat minor injuries, major bleeds and medical emergencies.
 4. Perform a secondary survey;
 5. Splint an arm injury;
 6. Treat minor injuries; and
 7. Follow prescribed WCB documentation guidelines.



Delivery Method

The Occupational First Aid Level 2 course is divided into 2 parts:

- Theory; and
- Practical.



Demonstration of Skills and Knowledge

- 1.5 hour Written Exam 70%
- Approximately 3 hour Practical Exam 70%
